



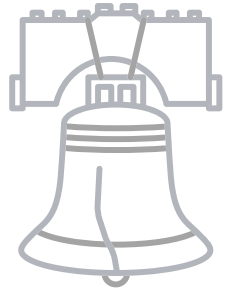

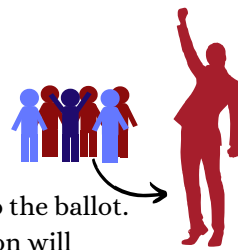
1. The Primary Election

- Held in the spring.
- Candidates running for office must declare their candidacy and circulate petitions to get their names on the ballot.
- In Pennsylvania only Republicans and Democrats participate in the Primary Election for the purpose of each party "picking their team" to move on to the November ballot.
- Several people from the same party may run for the same position. Voters are limited to cast votes for each position as explained on the ballot.
- The candidate(s) with the most votes will be declared the winner to move on to the ballot in General Election.
- Each precinct will have its own specific ballot. Candidates for Boro, Township, & School positions will vary by polling location.



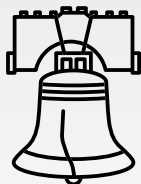
2. The General Election

- Held in November.
- Additional political parties may petition to be added to the ballot.
- Names of winning candidates from the Primary Election will appear on the ballot in addition to the minority party candidates.
- Candidates may choose to run a write-in campaign seeking voters to cast their vote using the write-in space on the ballot.
- Each precinct will have its own specific ballot. Candidates for Boro, Township, School and election positions will vary by polling location.

Signalling is among the most basic and widespread uses of bells, both now and in history, —marking significant points of ritual or tradition, call to worship, tolling the hours, announcing events, rejoicing, warning, and mourning.



During its functional lifetime, our nation's beloved Liberty Bell has called lawmakers to Assembly, called townspeople for the reading of the news, and marked the death of some of our country's most important Founding Fathers including General George Washington.

It's inscription has served to be the rally cry for many movements in our nation's history and pays tribute to the Christian faith of our Founding Fathers ~ "Proclaim Liberty Throughout All the Land Unto All the Inhabitants thereof." (Leviticus 25:10) This bell, displaying such a proclamation, has been a unifying keepsake especially for a fractured nation after the civil war.

It is our hope that this periodical will serve as a signal to it's readers much like The Liberty Bell served in marking events of the birth of a new and free nation.
